Burnaby Horsemen's Association Policy: Manure Shed

Approved: MARCH 28 2022

Applicability

This policy is to ensure the manure sheds provide a high-quality garden product for local gardeners while reducing our manure haul away costs. The manure shed disposal and pickup is advantageous for community, BHA and the environment.

Policy

BHA does not have the space or time required to make quality compost and therefore supplies the raw materials that gardeners need to make their own compost at home. Storing and providing the raw materials is a great way to recycle and to reduce our facility costs while providing a free product that the local gardening community values.

The following materials can go in the manure storage sheds:

- Manure (from either hogfuel or sand paddocks)
- Urine-soaked shavings or sawdust
- A minimal amount of hay (less than 5%)

The following materials cannot go in the manure storage sheds:

- Leaves
- Weeds
- Garbage of any kind

This policy was formulated by a Registered Professional Biologist with manure management and composting education experience.
