Complete the Membership Application (page 1), sign the Code of Conduct (page 2), initial (if agreed) points concerning receipt of emails, sharing of personal information and volunteering.

Include a photocopy of 2024 Horse Council of BC (HCBC) membership card.

Include signed ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY (Senior) or Junior form

Include a photocopy of BCID or BCDL confirming Burnaby residency (for Burnaby memberships only)

Include a completed <u>Stall Sublease Application form</u> (only if you wish to be placed on the Stall Waitlist)

Include appropriate payment (cash NOT accepted) for the correct membership fee.

Only fully completed application packages will be presented/accepted for consideration.

(HCBC) and submit a copy of your card.

Senior Membership (Burnaby) – City of Burnaby resident who is 19 years of age or older as of Jan 1st, 2024. Must submit photocopies of BCDL or BCID, and HCBC. **\$ 140.**

Senior Membership (Non-Burnaby) – 19 years of age or older as of Jan 1st, 2024. Must submit photocopy of individual HCBC. **\$ 165.**

Junior Membership (Burnaby) – City of Burnaby resident under 19 years of age as of Jan 1st, 2024 Must submit photocopies of Parent/Guardian BCDL or BCID and individual HCBC. **\$ 105.**

Junior Membership (Non Burnaby) – under 19 years of age as of Jan 1st, 2024. Must submit photocopy of individual HCBC. **\$ 125.**

Non-Riding Membership (Burnaby) – City of Burnaby resident. Must submit photocopies of BCDL or BCID. May only care for a horse or pony within the horse or pony's stall. **\$ 25.**

Recognize that the grounds of BHA are situated on the ancestral, traditional and unceded territory of the Coast Salish and Stó:lo peoples, including the kwikwəλəm (Kwikwetlem), xwməθkwəỷ əm (Musqueam), Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish), and Səlílwəta?/ Selilwitulh (Tsleil-Waututh) Nations and commit to learning about stewardship best practices from these nations.
- 6. Recognize BHA is a volunteer-based member-run organization, I will volunteer and participate in the democratic processes of the club.
- 7. Work to maintain a positive, welcoming community at BHA, and seek constructive avenues for solving interpersonal differences.
- 8. Not let personal interest or interpersonal conflict drive my decision making on BHA policy and procedures, either as a voting Member or in an elected position to BHA Board or Barn Committees.
